Discussion: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Increasing RPTL 467 Senior Exemption Income Limits for 2026 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Director Blancato will provide the committee with a draft of the proposed local law next Finance Committee. NYS Senate Bill S.01183 and Assembly Bill A.00074, <i>AN ACT to amend the real property tax law, in relation to establishing a real property tax exemption for veterans who have a one hundred percent service-connected disability</i>, was signed into law on 12/19/25; Chap. 672 of the laws of 2025 			
<p>Comments provided by Veteran Services Director, Anthony Solina, dated 01/05/26: <i>This bill is just a slight modification to an already existing NYS law. Previously, veterans who were rated 100% permanent and total and were in receipt of a specialty housing grant (also called pecuniary assistance under the law) were eligible while this new law expands it to those who are rated below 100% but are considered permanently unemployable (TDIU). The key provision is about the pecuniary assistance, as for the most part, those are soldiers who lost a limb in the war. An example is the Vietnam veteran who was our veteran of the month at the fair board meeting and had lost his leg while in service to his country in Vietnam, he receives the special housing grant, is 100% and thus he already pays no property taxes.</i></p> <p><i>The main thing is that the county and towns should be ready because there is already a push in the state to make ALL 100% permanent and total veterans exempt from property taxes, pending local laws approving it, so be ready.</i></p> <p><i>Bottom line, this new law would bring either none or almost no new veterans in our county under its umbrella, for now.</i></p>
