Community Health Assessment and Community Health Improvement Plan completed with GO Health and submitted to NYS Department of Health.</p> <p>Allison Robb, Public Health Program Specialist to provide an overview of the process, key findings and priority areas</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The CDC Public Health Infrastructure Grant funding was authorized to strengthen health department workforce and improve foundational capacities; WCHD applied and was approved for \$559,883.00 in funding from 12/1/2022 through 11/30/2027; Funds to date have been used for facility improvements, IT equipment replacement, vehicle purchase, staff retention and offset of approved wage adjustments; On 1/24/26, the CDC issued a stop work order to all states related to PHIG funding “to review and evaluate activities funding within this PHIG award program to ensure alignment with administration and agency priorities”; NYSDOH relayed the CDC emphasized the need for these funds to be spent fully, efficiently and in alignment with administration priorities and is advocating for the continuation of these funds beyond 2027; On 1/27/26 NYSDOH received official PHIG notice of award (NOA) reinstatement with no changes, signaling no interruption to PHIG activities at any level.
