UPDATED : Executive Order 202.6, "Essential Business,"

As of Friday, March 27th, 2020 @ 11am

The updated order now includes construction of residential and commercial projects and reads as follows;

Construction

- All non-essential construction must shut down except emergency construction, (e.g. a project necessary to protect health and safety of the occupants or to continue a project if it would be unsafe to allow it to remain undone until it is safe to shut the site).
- Essential construction may continue and includes roads, bridges, transit facilities, utilities, hospitals or health care facilities, affordable housing, and homeless shelters. At every site, if essential or emergency non-essential construction, this includes maintaining social distance, including for purposes of elevators/meals/entry and exit. Sites that cannot maintain distance and safety best practices must close and enforcement will be provided by the state in coordination with the city/local governments. This will include fines of up to \$10,000 per violation.
- For purposes of this section construction work does not include a single worker, who is the sole employee/worker on a job site.

Frequent Questions:

Q; If I am a sole proprietor, and have no employees, can I continue to work?

A; Yes, you must still practice social distancing

Q; If this is a project I feel may impact the health safety or welfare of the occupants can this be completed?

A; You are urged to contact our office to discuss your project 585-786-8820

Q; If I have started the re-roofing project, should I finish it?

A; Yes, if the project has already started and may impact the health safety or welfare of the occupants it should be completed

Q; I am a general contractor and have several job sites running, can I continue any of my projects?

A; The intent of the regulation is to create separateness in order to slow the further development of the virus. You are allowed to continue with 1 employee per site.
