Wyoming County Clerk, Rhonda Pierce, offered the following statement earlier today: The County Clerk's office will no longer require appointments effective June 29, 2020. We are back to normal hours of operation M - F 9:00 AM - 5:00 PM, recordings: 9:00 AM - 4:40 PM, pistol permits & passports: 9:00 AM - 4:30 PM. For any questions please call 585-786-8810 or email county.clerk@wyomingco.net. Social distancing, sanitation and mask wearing are still required.

The Warsaw DMV office continues to be open to Wyoming County residents only for specific in-office transactions. Permit testing for driver learner/motorcycle is now available as well as CDL testing. Appointments are needed for all permit testing. Office capacity will still be limited to 3 customers, only the customer listed on the transaction is allowed in the office. All customers will be required to wear a face covering in order to enter the office and continue to wear it unless directed otherwise by staff. Sanitation and social distancing continues to be a requirement.

We will continue to process transactions through the mail and the drop box. Please visit our website at www.wyomingco.net on the DMV page to view the transaction list which will advise you how to proceed. If you do not have access to the website, please call 585-786-8811, Mon - Fri, 9 AM - 4:45 PM. Please be advised, we have limited staff to answer phones, it may take several attempts to have your call answered. As we move forward, we will return to full DMV services.
