**Wyoming County Board of Supervisors Chairwoman, Rebecca J. Ryan**, reports, as of earlier today, Tuesday, October 27<sup>th</sup>, the Wyoming County Health Department reports one hundred ninety-four (194) lab-confirmed positive cases of COVID-19 among Wyoming County residents. This is an increase of two (2) cases from the last reported increase on Monday, October 26, 2020.
