**The Wyoming County Health Department will be offering FREE
COVID-19 rapid tests for those who live or work in Wyoming County**

**The next community testing event will be held Wednesday, January 13th
Details and registration information will be announced by Wednesday, January 6th**

How can I get a COVID-19 test in Wyoming County?

Wyoming County Board of Supervisors Chairwoman, Rebecca J. Ryan announced as of Tuesday, January 5, 2021, the Wyoming County Health Department reports one thousand two hundred fifty-seven (1,257) lab-confirmed positive community cases of COVID-19 among Wyoming County residents. This is an increase of twenty-eight (28) cases from the last reported increase on Monday, January 4, 2021.

From the New York State Department of Health (revised 1/5/2021): The first New Yorkers to receive the COVID-19 vaccine, as part of the New York State Vaccination Plan, are included in Phase 1A (see list below). If you are a member of one of these priority populations, watch for an email from your employer or sponsoring agency on how to register for an upcoming vaccination clinic. More information will be released next week for Wyoming County priority populations as guidance is issued by New York State. Phase 1A COVID-19 vaccination recipients include the following:

- High-risk hospital and FQHC staff, including OMH psychiatric centers;
- Emergency Medical Services Personnel;
- Coroners and funeral home workers;
- Staff and residents in congregate living situations run by the Office of People with Developmental Disabilities, Office of Mental Health Office of Addiction Services and Supports (OPWDD/OMH/OASAS);
- Urgent Care providers; staff administering COVID-19 Vaccinations;
- Outpatient/Ambulatory front-line, high-risk health care workers of any age who provide direct in-person patient care, or other staff in a position in which they have direct contact with patients (i.e., intake staff) individuals who work in private medical practices;
- Hospital-affiliated medical practices;
- Public health clinics;
- Specialty medical practices of all types;
- Dental practices of all types;
- Dialysis workers;
- Diagnostic and treatment centers;
- Occupational therapists; physical therapists and speech therapists;
- Phlebotomists;
- Behavioral health workers; and student health workers;
- All front-line, high-risk public health workers who have direct contact with patients, including those conducting COVID-19 tests, those handling COVID-19 lab specimens and COVID-19 vaccinations; home care workers and aides, hospice workers, personal care aides, and consumer-directed personal care workers;
- Staff and residents of nursing homes, skilled nursing facilities, and adult care facilities
