**The Wyoming County Health Department will be offering FREE
COVID-19 rapid tests for those who live or work in Wyoming County**

Registration is full for the COVID-19 RAPID TESTING clinic on Wednesday, January 20th

**Please arrive within a few minutes of your appointment time.
This site is drive through only - all individuals should remain in their cars**

From the New York State Department of Health: If you are in the Phase 1A or 1B Priority Population according to the NYS Department of Health ["Phased Distribution of the Vaccine"](#) guidelines, you are currently eligible to receive a COVID-19 vaccination.

The Wyoming County Health Department COVID-19 vaccine clinics for the week of January 11, 2021 are fully booked. More clinics will be announced when additional vaccine is received from New York State. Check back frequently at www.wyomingco.net for updated information. It is expected that pharmacy locations and physician practices in Wyoming County will receive vaccine directly from New York State in the coming days and weeks to vaccinate those that are eligible.

New York State estimates it may take up to three months to vaccinate everyone eligible in Phases 1A and 1B based on supply of vaccine.

Wyoming County Board of Supervisors Chairwoman, Rebecca J. Ryan announced as of Thursday, January 14, 2021, the Wyoming County Health Department reports one thousand five hundred twenty-one (1,521) lab-confirmed positive community cases of COVID-19 among Wyoming County residents. This is an increase of thirty-nine (39) cases from the last reported increase on Wednesday, January 13, 2021.
