COVID-19 rapid tests for those who live or work in Wyoming County**

**From the New York State Department of Health:** If you are in the Phase 1A or 1B Priority Population according to the NYS Department of Health "[Phased Distribution of the Vaccine](#)" guidelines, you are currently eligible to receive a COVID-19 vaccination.

The Wyoming County Health Department COVID-19 will schedule vaccination clinics when additional vaccine is received from New York State. Check back frequently at [www.wyomingco.net](http://www.wyomingco.net) for updated information. It is expected that more locations in Wyoming County will receive vaccine directly from New York State in the coming days and weeks to vaccinate those that are eligible.

It may take up to three months to vaccinate everyone eligible in Phases 1A and 1B based on supply of vaccine.

**Wyoming County Board of Supervisors Chairwoman, Rebecca J. Ryan** announced as of Monday, January 18, 2021, the Wyoming County Health Department reports one thousand six hundred thirty-nine (1,639) lab-confirmed positive community cases of COVID-19 among Wyoming County residents. This is an increase of seventy-one (71) cases from the last reported increase on Friday, January 15, 2021.
