From the New York State Department of Health:

If you are in the Phase 1A or 1B Priority Population according to the NYS Department of Health ["Phased Distribution of the Vaccine"](#) guidelines, you are currently eligible to receive a COVID-19 vaccination.

The Wyoming County Health Department COVID-19 received a small shipment of vaccine this week that New York State directed be administered in a specific way for those in eligible priority populations 1A & 1B. Registration filled for the clinic this week, there are no available appointments. The Health Department cannot take reservations over the phone. Check back frequently at www.wyomingco.net for updated information. It is expected that more locations in Wyoming County will receive vaccine directly from New York State in the coming days and weeks to vaccinate those that are eligible.

At current vaccine supply levels from NYS, it may take months to vaccinate everyone eligible in Phases 1A and 1B.

Wyoming County Board of Supervisors Chairwoman, Rebecca J. Ryan announced as of Wednesday, January 20, 2021, the Wyoming County Health Department reports one thousand six hundred eighty (1,680) lab-confirmed positive community cases of COVID-19 among Wyoming County residents. This is an increase of eighteen (18) cases from the last reported increase on Tuesday, January 19, 2021.
