From the Wyoming County Department of Health:

If you are in the Phase 1A or 1B Priority Population according to the NYS Department of Health ["Phased Distribution of the Vaccine"](#) guidelines, you are currently eligible to receive a COVID-19 vaccination.

Additional COVID-19 vaccination clinics will be scheduled when more vaccine is received. The Health Department cannot take reservations over the phone. Please check back frequently at www.wyomingco.net for updated information.

At current vaccine supply levels from NYS, it may take months to vaccinate everyone eligible in Phases 1A and 1B.

Wyoming County Board of Supervisors Chairwoman, Rebecca J. Ryan announced as of Tuesday, January 26, 2021, the Wyoming County Health Department reports one thousand eight hundred two (1,802) lab-confirmed positive community cases of COVID-19 among Wyoming County residents. This is an increase of forty-one (41) cases from the last reported increase on Monday, January 25, 2021.
