**From the Wyoming County Department of Health:**

If you are a member of Phase 1A or 1B Priority Population according to the NYS Department of Health ["Phased Distribution of the Vaccine"](#) guidelines, you are currently eligible to receive a COVID-19 vaccination.

Beginning February 15<sup>th</sup>, according to the NYS Department of Health: adults of any age with certain pre-existing conditions are eligible to be vaccinated at specific vaccination locations. The Health Department has been allocated 200 doses of Moderna COVID-19 vaccine, however the shipment has been delayed due to weather. **NEW:** Free COVID-19 rapid testing will be available by appointment at the Health Department each week. **Wyoming County Board of Supervisors Chairwoman, Rebecca J. Ryan** announced as of Wednesday, February 17, 2021, the Wyoming County Health Department reports two thousand thirty-one (2,031) lab-confirmed positive community cases of COVID-19 among Wyoming County residents. This is an increase of four (4) cases from the last reported increase on Tuesday, February 16, 2021.
