**From the Wyoming County Department of Health:**

If you are a member of Phase 1A or 1B Priority Population according to the NYS Department of Health [“Phased Distribution of the Vaccine”](#) guidelines, you are currently eligible to receive a COVID-19 vaccination.

Effective February 15, 2021: Adult New Yorkers of any age with the following conditions qualify for the vaccine:

- Cancer (current or in remission, including 9/11-related cancers)
- Chronic kidney disease
- Pulmonary Disease, including but not limited to, COPD (chronic obstructive pulmonary disease), asthma (moderate-to-severe), pulmonary fibrosis, cystic fibrosis, and 9/11 related pulmonary diseases
- Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities including Down Syndrome
- Heart conditions, including but not limited to heart failure, coronary artery disease, cardiomyopathies, or hypertension (high blood pressure)
- Immunocompromised state (weakened immune system) including but not limited to solid organ transplant or from blood or bone marrow transplant, immune deficiencies, HIV, use of corticosteroids, use of other immune weakening medicines, or other causes
- Severe Obesity (BMI 40 kg/m<sup>2</sup>), Obesity (body mass index [BMI] of 30 kg/m<sup>2</sup> or higher but < 40 kg/m<sup>2</sup>)
- Pregnancy
- Sickle cell disease or Thalassemia
- Type 1 or 2 diabetes mellitus
- Cerebrovascular disease (affects blood vessels and blood supply to the brain)
- Neurologic conditions including but not limited to Alzheimer's Disease or dementia
- Liver disease

**NEW:** There will be a COVID-19 Moderna vaccination clinic held on Wednesday, 2/24 from 9am to 12:00pm for adults with the pre-existing health conditions above; you must have an appointment to be vaccinated.

**Wyoming County Board of Supervisors Chairwoman, Rebecca J. Ryan** announced as of Tuesday, February 23, 2021, the Wyoming County Health Department reports two thousand seventy-seven (2,077) lab-confirmed positive community cases of COVID-19 among Wyoming County residents. This is an increase of thirteen (13) cases from the last reported increase on Monday, February 22, 2021.
