From the Wyoming County Department of Health:

NEW: There will be a COVID-19 Moderna vaccination clinic held on Wednesday, March 3 from 9am to 12:30pm. According to directions from New York State, this clinic is only for essential workers in Priority Population 1B (this includes fire, law enforcement, public safety/communications, corrections, P-12 education employees, in-person college faculty, employees of registered group childcare programs, public transit, public-facing grocery workers & hotel workers, restaurant employees and others). Individuals being vaccinated must bring proof of eligibility to the vaccination site. This could be an employee ID card, a letter from an employer or affiliated organization, or a pay stub.

Wyoming County Board of Supervisors Chairwoman, Rebecca J. Ryan announced as of Monday, March 1, 2021, the Wyoming County Health Department reports two thousand one hundred sixteen (2,116) lab-confirmed positive community cases of COVID-19 among Wyoming County residents. This is an increase of twenty (20) cases from the last reported increase on Friday, February 26, 2021.
