From the Wyoming County Department of Health:

NEW: There will be a Pfizer COVID-19 vaccination clinic on Tuesday, March 9th at Wyoming County Highway. This clinic is for residents of Wyoming County, ages 65 years and older only.

NEW: New York State launched a “COVID-19 Vaccine Tracker” website ([HERE](#)). As of March 4th, it is reported that 13.6% of Wyoming County residents have at least one COVID-19 vaccine dose (NYS average is 16.2%).

Wyoming County Board of Supervisors Chairwoman, Rebecca J. Ryan announced as of Friday, March 5, 2021, the Wyoming County Health Department reports two thousand one hundred fifty-two (2,152) lab-confirmed positive community cases of COVID-19 among Wyoming County residents. This is an increase of fourteen (14) cases from the last reported increase on Thursday, March 4, 2021.
