From the Wyoming County Department of Health:

NEW: There will be a COVID-19 Moderna vaccination clinic for those that are eligible to be vaccinated and either live or work in Wyoming County. The clinic will be on Wednesday, March 24 from 1:00pm to 4:15pm at the Wyoming County Highway Department. According to updated guidance from New York State, this clinic is **for anyone currently eligible for COVID-19 vaccination** per NYS Guidance ["Phased Distribution of the Vaccine"](#). Beginning tomorrow, March 23rd, this now includes those ages 50 years and older. Essential workers being vaccinated should bring proof of eligibility to the vaccination site. This could be an employee ID card, a letter from an employer or affiliated organization, or a pay stub.

Wyoming County Board of Supervisors Chairwoman, Rebecca J. Ryan announced as of Monday, March 22, 2021, the Wyoming County Health Department reports two thousand two hundred sixty-six (2,266) lab-confirmed positive community cases of COVID-19 among Wyoming County residents. This is an increase of eighteen (18) cases from the last reported increase on Friday, March 19, 2021.
