**Wyoming County Board of Supervisors Chairwoman, Rebecca J. Ryan** announced as of Thursday, March 25, 2021, the Wyoming County Health Department reports two thousand two hundred eighty-two (2,282) lab-confirmed positive community cases of COVID-19 among Wyoming County residents. This is an increase of six (6) cases from the last reported increase on Wednesday, March 24, 2021.
