NEW: There are appointments remaining for the COVID-19 Moderna vaccination clinic on Thursday, April 8 from 8:30am to 4:30pm at the Wyoming County Highway Department. This clinic is for anyone ages 18 and older.

An appointment is required in order to be vaccinated. The Health Department is noting an increase in community cases. Residents are asked to please continue to be vigilant - wear a face covering in public, maintain social distance and practice good hand hygiene. Please get COVID vaccinated to protect yourself, your family and our most vulnerable community members.

Wyoming County Board of Supervisors Chairwoman, Rebecca J. Ryan announced as of Wednesday, April 7, 2021, the Wyoming County Health Department reports two thousand three hundred seventy-four (2,374) lab-confirmed positive community cases of COVID-19 among Wyoming County residents. This is an increase of seventeen (17) cases from the last reported increase on Tuesday, April 6, 2021.
