Wyoming County Board of Supervisors Chairwoman, Rebecca J. Ryan announced as of Monday, April 19, 2021, the Wyoming County Health Department reports two thousand four hundred seventy-five (2,475) lab-confirmed positive community cases of COVID-19 among Wyoming County residents. This is an increase of twenty-eight (28) cases from the last reported increase on Friday, April 16, 2021.
