NEW: Still need a COVID vaccine? There are convenient options close to home:

- Wyoming County Health Department walk-in COVID vaccination clinic from 5pm to 7pm on Monday, May 10th at the Health Department, 5362 Mungers Mill Road, Silver Springs. Just bring ID and your health insurance card. This will be 1st dose Moderna vaccine. Call 786-8890 with questions.
- Wyoming County Family Medicine-Arcade at 492-5088 and Wyoming County Internal Medicine in Warsaw at 786-2290 have Johnson & Johnson and Moderna Vaccines available, please call to schedule an appointment.
- Visit the VaccineFinder website [HERE](#) to search for available COVID vaccine by location and vaccine type. Call the Health Department at 786-8890 for assistance.

Once fully vaccinated, if you are exposed to someone with COVID, you will not be considered a close contact and will not be subject to mandatory quarantine. 36.8% of Wyoming County residents have received at least one dose of COVID-19 vaccine. The best way to protect yourself and others as NYS restrictions are lifted is to be vaccinated.

Wyoming County Board of Supervisors Chairwoman, Rebecca J. Ryan announced as of Tuesday, May 4, 2021, the Wyoming County Health Department reports two thousand six hundred twenty-three (2,623) lab-confirmed positive community cases of COVID-19 among Wyoming County residents. This is an increase of five (5) cases from the last reported increase on Monday, May, 2021.
