The [VaccineFinder website](#) is available to search for local COVID-19 vaccinations by zip code and vaccine type. Reminder, the Johnson & Johnson is the single-dose vaccine for anyone age 18 and older. The Moderna vaccine is a 2-shot series, 28 days apart, for anyone age 18 and older. The Pfizer vaccine is a 2-shot series, 21 days apart for anyone ages 12 years and older. For more detailed information about the COVID-19 vaccines available, visit the [CDC website](#).

As of today, the 7-day rolling average positivity rate in Wyoming County is 2.5%, compared to 2.2% in the Finger Lakes region and 0.8% in New York State.

**Wyoming County Board of Supervisors Chairwoman, Rebecca J. Ryan** announced as of Thursday, May 27, 2021, the Wyoming County Health Department reports two thousand seven hundred fifty-three (2,753) lab-confirmed positive community cases of COVID-19 among Wyoming County residents. This is an increase of five (5) cases from the last reported increase on Tuesday, May 25, 2021.
