**PRESS RELEASE

NEW: There will be a walk-in COVID-19 community vaccination clinic on **Friday, July 16, 2021 from 9:00am to 4:00pm** at the Wyoming County Health Department at 5362 Mungers Mill Road, Silver Springs (approximately 2.5 miles south of the Village of Warsaw). Pfizer and Johnson & Johnson vaccine will be available.

The single-dose Johnson & Johnson vaccine will be available for anyone 18 years and older. A limited number of Pfizer vaccine will be available for anyone 12 years and older; a parent or guardian must accompany those under age 18 for consent to be vaccinated.

Please bring identification and proof of insurance. If you are uninsured, there is no charge. Call the Health Department at 786-8890 with questions.

Wyoming County Board of Supervisors Chairwoman, Rebecca J. Ryan announced as of Thursday, July 15, 2021, the Wyoming County Health Department reports two thousand seven hundred eighty-three (2,783) lab-confirmed positive community cases of COVID-19 among Wyoming County residents. There is an increase of fifteen (15) cases since the last reported increase on Friday, July 2, 2021. There are six (6) laboratory-confirmed active COVID-19 cases in Wyoming County as of today.
