NEW: Vaccination Clinics

There will be Pfizer community vaccination clinics on Monday, August 16th & Wednesday, August 18th from 12:00PM to 3:00PM at the Wyoming County Health Department Fair booth.

On Monday, August 23rd 11:00 AM to 1:00 PM there will be Pfizer community vaccination clinic at the Attica Public Library.

Pfizer vaccine is for anyone 12 years and older. Children under 18 must be accompanied by a parent or caregiver that can provide consent.

Please bring identification and proof of insurance. If you are uninsured, there is no charge. Call the Health Department at 786-8890 with questions.

Wyoming County Board of Supervisors Chairwoman, Rebecca J. Ryan announced as of Thursday, August 12, 2021, the Wyoming County Health Department reports two thousand eight hundred eighteen (2,818) lab-confirmed positive community cases of COVID-19 among Wyoming County residents. There is an increase of ten (10) cases since the last reported increase on Thursday, August 5, 2021. There are currently eight (8) laboratory-confirmed active COVID-19 cases in Wyoming County. The Centers for Disease Control characterizes COVID community transmission in Wyoming County as "Moderate" between August 4 and August 10, 2021.
