**NEW: Vaccination Clinic**

Registration is open for a Pfizer community vaccination clinic September 17th from 9:00AM to 12:00PM at the Wyoming County Health Department. You must register to receive a vaccination. Registration can be done online by visiting:

Pfizer vaccine is for anyone 12 years and older. Children under 18 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian that can provide consent. Please bring identification and proof of insurance. If you are uninsured, there is no charge. Call the Health Department at 786-8890 with questions or if you need assistance registering.

**Wyoming County Board of Supervisors Chairwoman, Rebecca J. Ryan** announced as of Thursday, September 9, 2021, the Wyoming County Health Department reports two thousand nine hundred thirty-seven (2,937) lab-confirmed positive community cases of COVID-19 among Wyoming County residents. There is an increase of forty-nine (49) cases since the last reported increase on Thursday, September 2, 2021. There are currently forty-two (42) laboratory-confirmed active COVID-19 cases in Wyoming County.

The Centers for Disease Control characterizes COVID community transmission in Wyoming County as “High” between September 2 and September 8, 2021.

The CDC recommends wearing of face masks for vaccinated and non-vaccinated individuals indoors and in public settings. The community is strongly encouraged to promote behaviors that prevent spread and maintain healthy environments, such as cleaning high touch surfaces, ensuring clean ventilation systems, and allowing for social distancing.
