NEW: Vaccination Clinic

Registration is open for a community vaccination clinic October 1st from 9:00AM to 12:00PM at the Wyoming County Health Department. You must register to receive a vaccination. Registration can be done online by visiting: www.wyomingco.net and selecting the “COVID-19 vaccination” *quick link*. Pfizer and J&J/Janssen COVID-19 Vaccine will be available at this clinic. J&J/Janssen vaccine is for anyone 18 years and older. Pfizer vaccine is for anyone 12 years and older. Children under 18 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian that can provide consent. Please bring identification and proof of insurance. If you are uninsured, there is no charge. Call the Health Department at 786-8890 with questions or if you need assistance registering.

Wyoming County Board of Supervisors Chairwoman, Rebecca J. Ryan announced as of Thursday, September 23, 2021, the Wyoming County Health Department reports three thousand eighty-three (3,083) lab-confirmed positive community cases of COVID-19 among Wyoming County residents. There is an increase of seventy (70) cases since the last reported increase on Thursday, September 16, 2021. There are currently forty-eight (48) laboratory-confirmed active COVID-19 cases in Wyoming County.

The Centers for Disease Control characterizes COVID community transmission in Wyoming County as “High” between September 15 and September 21, 2021.

The CDC recommends wearing of face masks for vaccinated and non-vaccinated individuals indoors and in public settings. The community is strongly encouraged to promote behaviors that prevent spread and maintain healthy environments, such as cleaning high touch surfaces, ensuring clean ventilation systems, and allowing for social distancing.
