NEW: Vaccination Clinics

1. Registration is open for a community vaccination clinic **October 1st** from 9:00AM to 12:00PM at the Wyoming County Health Department.
 - Pfizer and J&J/Janssen COVID-19 Vaccine will be available at this clinic.
 - You must register to receive a vaccination.
2. Registration is open for a community vaccination clinic **October 5th** from 9:00AM to 12:00PM at the Wyoming County Health Department.
 - This clinic is open for Pfizer, J&J/Janssen or Booster* dose Pfizer vaccine
 - *only those who have received 2 doses of Pfizer more than 6 months ago are eligible.

Registration can be completed online by visiting: www.wyomingco.net and selecting the “COVID-19 vaccination” *quick link*.

- ❖ J&J/Janssen vaccine is for anyone 18 years and older.
- ❖ Pfizer vaccine is for anyone 12 years and older.
- ❖ Children under 18 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian that can provide consent.

Please bring identification and proof of insurance. If you are uninsured, there is no charge. Call the Health Department at 786-8890 with questions or if you need assistance registering.

Currently, in accordance with CDC guidance, the following groups of New Yorkers **should** receive their COVID-19 booster vaccine dose:

- New Yorkers 65 years and older or residents in long-term care settings,
- New Yorkers aged 50–64 years with underlying medical conditions.

The following groups of New Yorkers **may** receive their COVID-19 booster vaccine dose:

- New Yorkers aged 18–49 years with underlying medical conditions, based on their individual benefits and risks, and
- New Yorkers aged 18–64 years who are at increased risk for COVID-19 exposure and transmission because of occupational or institutional setting, based on their individual benefits and risks.

Wyoming County Board of Supervisors Chairwoman, Rebecca J. Ryan announced as of Thursday, September 30, 2021, the Wyoming County Health Department reports three thousand one hundred sixty-four (3,164) lab-confirmed positive community cases of COVID-19 among Wyoming County residents. There is an

increase of eighty-one (81) cases since the last reported increase on Thursday, September 23, 2021. There are currently fifty-seven (57) laboratory-confirmed active COVID-19 cases in Wyoming County.

The Centers for Disease Control characterizes COVID community transmission in Wyoming County as “High” between September 23 and September 29, 2021.

The CDC recommends wearing of face masks for vaccinated and non-vaccinated individuals indoors and in public settings. The community is strongly encouraged to promote behaviors that prevent spread and maintain healthy environments, such as cleaning high touch surfaces, ensuring clean ventilation systems, and allowing for social distancing.
