Tuesday 11/16/2021 Pfizer Vaccination First Dose & Pfizer Booster

The COVID-19 vaccine is safe and effective. Everyone five (5) years and older are eligible to receive a vaccine. Wyoming County Health Department encourages Wyoming County residents who are not fully vaccinated to begin their COVID-19 vaccine series. COVID-19 vaccination is especially important for youth and families attending school or child care.

Wyoming County Board of Supervisors Chairwoman, Rebecca J. Ryan announced as of Wednesday, November 10, 2021, the Wyoming County Health Department reports three thousand seven hundred ninety-six (3,796) lab-confirmed positive community cases of COVID-19 among Wyoming County residents. There is an increase of ninety-eight (98) cases since the last reported increase on Thursday, November 4, 2021. There are currently eighty-one (81) laboratory-confirmed active COVID-19 cases in Wyoming County.

The CDC recommends wearing of face masks for vaccinated and non-vaccinated individuals indoors and in public settings. The community is strongly encouraged to promote behaviors that prevent spread and maintain healthy environments, such as cleaning high touch surfaces, ensuring clean ventilation systems, and allowing for social distancing.
