Booster* Vaccinations:

Moderna Booster – Monday, 1/3/2022 from 2pm to 4pm
Moderna Booster – Tuesday, 1/4/2022 from 9am to noon

Initial Vaccinations:

First Dose Pfizer Ages 5-11 – Tuesday, 1/4/2022 from 1pm to 3pm
First Dose Pfizer Ages 12 and older - Tuesday, 1/4/22 from 1pm to 3pm
First Dose Moderna – Tuesday, 1/4/2022 from 9am to noon
First Dose Moderna – Friday, 1/7/2022 from 10am to noon

New York State allocated a supply of KN95 masks to Wyoming County. These masks are available throughout our communities to help prevent the spread of illness during the winter months. Residents can pick up masks at the Health Department during business hours. Local businesses who would like a supply of masks can contact the Wyoming County Chamber of Commerce at 786-0307.

The Wyoming County Health Department continues to offer COVID-19 testing on Monday, Wednesday and Friday each week. Testing will be “drive through” style at the Wyoming County Highway Department located at 4328 Route 19, approximately 4 miles south of the Village of Warsaw. Results are available the same day and there is no charge. Wyoming County Board of Supervisors Chairwoman, Rebecca J. Ryan announced as of Thursday, December 30, 2021, the Wyoming County Health Department reports five thousand seventy-eight (5,078) lab-confirmed positive community cases of COVID-19 among Wyoming County residents. There is an increase of one hundred thirty-seven (137) cases since the last reported increase on Thursday, December 23, 2021. There are currently eighty (80) laboratory-confirmed active COVID-19 cases in Wyoming County.
