NEW:

- **WHEN YOU TEST POSITIVE FOR COVID-19:** New York State is moving toward a system of self-management when a person is positive for COVID-19 after being tested in a community setting (pharmacy, provider office, testing site etc). According to the NYS Department of Health, residents who test positive for COVID-19 will be directed to a NYS website for isolation and quarantine instructions. If you are COVID-19 positive, notify your close contacts that they have been exposed. NYSDOH “Frequently Asked Questions” about these changes will be available [HERE](#).
- **CURRENT CONTACT TRACING INFORMATION:** Wyoming County will conduct very limited case investigations; only for those who test positive for COVID-19 under age 18, over age 65 and those living in congregate settings. This is in an effort to keep students in school and protect those that may be more vulnerable to serious outcomes with COVID-19 infection.
- **WHEN YOU TEST POSITIVE WITH COVID-19 AT-HOME TEST:** Residents can visit www.wyomingco.net and choose “Report a Positive COVID-19 Home Test” under the “*Quick Links*” option to self-report a positive at home COVID-19 test. After submitting your result you will be able to print an “AFFIRMATION OF ISOLATION”. The state is moving to self-management for anyone who tests positive or who is exposed.
- **AT HOME COVID-19 TEST KITS:** Libraries in Wyoming County are out of COVID-19 test kits. If another supply is allocated for community distribution, community member will be advised. ***The Health Department does not have free at-home test kits or KN95 masks; please do not call or visit the Health Department for test kits or masks.***

The Wyoming County Health Department continues to offer COVID-19 testing on Monday, Wednesday and Friday each week. Testing will be “drive through” style at the Wyoming County Highway Department located at 4328 Route 19, approximately 4 miles south of the Village of Warsaw. Results are available the same day and there is no charge. Wyoming County Board of Supervisors Chairwoman, Rebecca J. Ryan announced as of Thursday, January 13, 2022, the Wyoming County Health Department reports six thousand five hundred seventy-three (6,573) lab-confirmed positive community cases of COVID-19 among Wyoming County residents. There is an increase of six hundred ten (610) total cases since the last reported increase on Thursday, January 6, 2021.
