- Libraries in Wyoming County have a limited supply of COVID-19 test kits and KN95 masks to distribute to residents during normal business hours. The Health Department does not have at-home test kits or KN95 masks; please do not call or visit the Health Department for test kits or masks.
- The Wyoming County Chamber of Commerce has received a limited number of COVID-19 test kits for businesses and individuals. The kits will be distributed on a first-come/first-serve basis. Limited KN95 masks are also available. If you are interested in receiving a test kit or masks, send an email to sgardner@wycochamber.org to make arrangements for pickup.
- Wyoming County residents can visit www.wyomingco.net and choose “Report a Positive COVID-19 Home Test” option under *Quick Links* to self-report a positive at home COVID-19 test. After submitting a positive result you will be able to print an “AFFIRMATION OF ISOLATION” if needed for school or work. The state has moved to self-management for anyone who tests positive or who is exposed to COVID-19.

Wyoming County Board of Supervisors Chairwoman, Rebecca J. Ryan announced as of Thursday, February 17, 2022, the Wyoming County Health Department reports seven thousand six hundred fifty-three (7,653) lab-confirmed positive community cases of COVID-19 among Wyoming County residents. There is an increase of sixty (60) total cases since the last reported increase on Thursday, February 10, 2022.
